d. Discussion on floor paint for extension floor. Derick Friswell raised concerns over the use of a clear top coat over the 2-pack epoxy base. The system was originally quoted & recommended by both The Paint Place & Crowies. Committee agreed to paint the floor using the base coat only. A decision to use a top clear coat can be determined later.

e. Need Storeroom & back are cleared of all cupboards & debris.

f. Power-point to be installed over new storeroom benchtop & emergency light to be replaced in general meeting room. Secretary to contact Lonergan & Muhovics.

g. Are the concrete wheel stops going to be correctly located and fixed in position. Yes, these are now positioned and do not require anchoring due to their weight.

h. Carpet tiles. Discussed quotes received. Continue to look at alternate suppliers.
